Foreword

How good is your hospital? Maybe you think it's among the very best, perhaps basing this on patient surveys, their comments on social media or maybe your hospital's regional ranking as per a magazine. All of these criteria can be useful for ranking a hospital—but there's a problem. They're all subjective. None of them is a strictly quantitative measure that really lets you compare your hospital or clinic with other institutions based on real-world, practical criteria. Instead, we have to depend on vague opinions and assumptions instead of precisely defined evaluations based on solid data.

And the reality is, up to now it's been impossible to provide any type of comparison between Latin American hospitals. There was hardly any information available about them, and what was available was either out-of-date or totally incorrect. In addition, no one really understood which type of criteria should be employed as a basis for comparison between Latin American hospitals.

However, at Global Health Intelligence we've spent years studying Latin American hospitals and gathering data about them. That's how we created HospiScope, the largest database in the world focused on demographic data about hospitals in Latin America. HospiScope covers nearly 90% of the hospitals in the region and offers more than 130 data points for each institution that it covers. We used our expertise and data to create HospiCheck, the tool that has produced this report that you're now reviewing. We surveyed thousands of hospitals to obtain honest answers about them. Then we partnered with experts in artificial intelligence and machine learning to perform the technological integration and statistical analysis to create this report. Now you can see what other hospitals and clinics—institutions just like yours—have in terms of specific types of equipment, infrastructure, technology and more.

You just have to go to each section and look for the benchmarks, that is, the medians that are the basis for comparison. Immediately you'll be able to analyze your own institution to see how it compares with the other medical institutions: in which aspects your institution is outstanding, in which aspects it is average and in which it's below average. So instead of evaluating your institution solely with patient impressions or a subjective ranking based on criteria that are not very solid, now you have clear, simple data that makes an enormous difference in terms of your institution's readiness level to take care of your patients to achieve optimal clinical outcomes, as well as helping you conduct a realistic evaluation of your institution.

Understanding Your HospiCheck Report

The data showcased in HospiCheck is powered by HospiScope, a database of more than 20,000 hospitals throughout Latin America—covering more than 90% of the hospitals in the region.

Developed and launched by Global Health Intelligence in 2015, HospiScope is updated annually by a team of researchers to ensure that is contains the very latest data on hospitals while also striving to constantly increase coverage.

HospiCheck is a benchmarking tool, designed to help you compare the infrastructure of your hospital against a peer group of similar hospitals you seek to evaluate your hospital against.

HospiCheck Process

There was a four-step process in producing your HospiCheck report:

We start with your data, asking you to complete a detailed online form that takes 15-20 minutes to complete. This gives us the initial basis for comparison.

After entering the data, you selected the general basis of comparison, including the country, type of institution and the size of institutions you want to compare yourself against. For example, if you selected "Mexico," "Private hospitals," "10-39 beds" your report will compare the data you entered against the median data for private hospitals in Mexico that have 10-39 beds in the HospiScope database. If you were to choose "Mexico" and "public and private," the report would reflect the comparison of your hospital with the median data for both **public and private** hospitals in Mexico.



Reading Your Report

As you review the report, you will notice a couple of different measures.

In some areas, the data is expressed as a general percentage. In this instance, for Level of Care, you see the median percentages of hospitals with this level of care for the benchmark selected. The data in orange reflects the responses that you captured for your institution.








What If You're Missing Data?



Note: In this section, rather than the median totals shown in other section, the results reflect the responses of the 18,000+ hospitals in our database to these questions. So for example, with the question "Does your institution have an Internet connection?", the percentages of hospitals that replied both "yes" and "no" are indicated. Also shown is your response to this question, which is represented by the orange bar in the response and the words "your institution." This allows you to see where your response falls within the responses of the hospitals in our database.

So for example, if you responded "yes" to this question, you'd see "Your institution" next to the "yes" response, the bar next to "yes" will be orange and you'll also see the percentage of all hospitals in our database that responded "yes", "no" or "I don't know . " If 80% responded "yes", then your institution would be in line with 80% of the hospitals in our database.


